REFLECT

Assess yourself over the past 120 days using the following questions:

How is your walk with the Lord?

- Are you saved? Do you have assurance of your salvation?
 - Has there been a time when you have repented of your sin?
 - Has there been a time when you have believed on the Lord Jesus Christ?
 - Has there been a time when you received Jesus into your life?
- Do you sense the Holy Spirit's presence in your life (guiding you, comforting you)?
- When you sin, does it immediately bother you?
- Do you have a desire for God (to magnify Him, worship Him publicly and privately)?
- Do you spend time reading the Bible on a regular basis?
- Do you spend time praying to God on a regular basis?
- Do you desire to walk in obedience to God?
- Have you lost the joy of your salvation?
- Do you have a plan to read through the Bible?
- Have you shared your faith with someone in the last month?
- Have you invited someone to church within the last month?
- Are you currently involved in a mentor/discipleship relationship?

How is your home life?

- If you are single, are you walking in discipline and purity?
- If you are married, how is your relationship with your spouse?
- If you have children, how are you doing as a parent?
- If you have parents living, are you honoring them?
- How are you relating to your extended family members?

How is your work/school life?

- Do you work well under your supervisor's/teacher's authority?

- Are you involved in any inappropriate behavior at work/school?

How are your relationships?

- Is there anyone toward whom you feel bitter?
- Do you have any "broken relationships"?
- Is there anyone who has wronged you that you have not forgiven?
- Is there anyone you have wronged who you have not asked to forgive you?
- Do you have any inappropriate relationships?

How are your finances?

- Do you practice "storehouse tithing"?
- Are you a godly steward of what God has entrusted to you?
- Do you spend more than you make?
- Do you pay your bills on time?
- Do you live within your financial means?
- Do you ever give anonymously to people in need?
